

**Frequently asked questions by applicants:**

1. **Do I need to take any college courses before beginning the program at Northeastern Hospital School of Nursing?** YES
2. **What courses are required before entrance?** Please see the other side of this paper the first block under Pre-Requisite Courses.
3. **What type of degree will I receive from Northeastern Hospital School of Nursing?** A Diploma in Nursing
4. **How long is the program?** If you begin in January it is 27 months, if you begin in May it is 24 months. The January program allows you to take N100, Pharmacology and N101 in the Spring Semester and leaves you with Diet 111 to take in the Summer. In the summer we can help you register at CCP (Community College of Phila.) to take the two senior level CCP courses Soc. 233 and Anth. 112, along with Diet 111. Both January and May groups join each other and form one class in September for the N200 courses. Both groups graduate in May two years after they begin the program.
5. **How much does the program cost?** \$21,400.00
6. **How does the application process work?** Submit your application (including your essay and application fee) and 2 references to the school. Request that your high school and college transcripts be sent directly to the school. When the school receives your application package, you will then receive a letter informing you what documents are needed to complete the file. After your file is complete and the due date for all application passes, the Admission Committee will process your application. Once admission requirements are met, you will be notified of when you will be scheduled to take the Pre-Entrance Test. During this time you can call the school and check on the status of your application.
7. **How long does this process take?** We will evaluate your application for the period for which you applied. If for some reason you need to reschedule your entrance from January until May, you need to call the school and request that your application be evaluated for the May program. After that application year, your application will be destroyed if it is incomplete when the committee evaluates it. During that time we expect to hear from you and we request that you send in your grade reports as you complete a semester at college. You will be notified by mail before your file is closed.
8. **With college pre-requisite courses and the nursing program, how long will it take to pursue my RN Diploma?** If you attend Community College of Philadelphia or a college of your choice beginning in the summer and continue taking courses during the fall and spring semesters, and are accepted into the Nursing Program, you should be able to complete the nursing program in 27 or 24 months at Northeastern Hospital School of Nursing.

**After graduating high school in June and seeking May enrollment the next year, below is an example of a course roster that would need to be followed.**

Biology 109 (A&P I) English 101	Biology 110 (A&P II) English 102 Intermediate Algebra, (Math 118) Psychology 101	Biology 241 (Micro) Developmental Psych.215 Sociology 101 Introduction to Chemistry, (Chem 101 or 110)

***You could also take Diet 111, Soc. 233 and Anth. 112 at College and transfer all three courses into NEHSON. It would lighten your semesters once you start taking Nursing Courses.***
